Be Careful - Be Awesome - Be Happy - Be Smart - Be Yourself

DOOR MATS / TOYS etc. ON THE GRASS: Small mats, NOT BIGGER THAN 2' x 4', may be used and must be picked up when you go home. Pools, tents and play mats may be used and must be put away daily. Kayaks, inflatables, door mats, water toys, etc. must be stored off the ground when not in use. *Sorry, this stuff kills the grass and the park manager is a tree-hugging hippie.*

TRAFFIC: 15mph speed limit. No dirt bikes, 4-wheelers, Go-Carts. No off-road driving. OHV's must be licensed, registered and insured. Licensed drivers / OHV Permit holders only.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed in any buildings or public areas including the fish cleaning stations, vault toilets and boat launches. *(Ok, but ESPECIALLY in the vault toilets!)*

LONG TERM STAYS: If you will be camping for longer than 7 days, you must maintain the area in and around your site. Mowers and trimmers are available at the Bait Shop. *Chop-Chop!*

SITE USE: Your campsite may be used by you and your immediate family only. Sub-letting of sites is not allowed. **External storage of appliances, water/propane tanks and utility trailers is not allowed.** Commercial activities are not allowed at camp sites. Toys, bikes, chairs must be neatly stored when site is not in use. *All Army Corps of Engineers rules for camping and land use apply within Van Hook Recreation Area.*

Van Hook Resort Recreation Area Rules



Be Kind - Be Considerate - Be Clean - Be Respectful - Be Cool

QUIET HOURS: 11pm - 7am. No idling engines, loud gatherings, barking dogs, music, etc. IF WE HAVE TO ASK YOU TO "SHUT DOWN IT DOWN AFTER 11PM YOU WILL BE FINED \$75.

GENERATORS: The ONLY generators allowed in the park are quiet running models that operate at/under a level of 60 decibels at a distance of 50ft. Generators in compliance with this rule may run within Non-Electric RV & Overflow Sites without restriction. Non-compliant Generators ARE NOT ALLOWED TO OPERATE WITHIN THE PARK, EVER...uuummmm, like, EVER.

TRASH: Dumpsters are located at the East end of the park. *DO NOT BURN TRASH, JACKWAGON!*

FIRES: Burn within fire rings only. Do not move the fire rings. Do not your leave trash in fire rings, duh. Firewood stored at sites rented for more than 7 days must be stored up off the grass. *A FIRE RING OF TRASH OR SITES FULL OF CIG BUTTS, \$75 FINE. HANDLE YO'SELF!*

CHECK-IN/CAMPING: All campers & lot guests must register at the Bait Shop upon arrival. *NO CAMP TAG = \$75 FINE + CAMPING FEES + ADIOS AMIGO.* Camping is allowed in designated areas only. Parking in sites must be conducted as per the instructions on the site # post. If you have questions, ask before you park. *(Ask an ADULT MANAGER, not a random teenager.)*

TENTS: All tents/rv's must have a camping permit. 1 SITE + 1 RV + 1 TENT = 2 CAMP TAGS. *NO CAMP TAG...\$75 FINE. Hey! I think I see a pattern here, do you?*

PETS: If your pet wanders or is aggressive, LEASH AT ALL TIMES. Pets may not be left alone, outside at camp sites. KEEP YOUR FURRY FRIEND HAPPY AND QUIET. Clean up after your pet. *SITE FULL OF POO...\$75 CLEANING FEE. Dang...being a jackwagon is expensive...*

FIREWORKS: Nope. Fireworks are prohibited within camping areas & leased lots. *DON'T EVEN THINK ABOUT IT! ...you are thinking about it...stop it. If it goes "BOOM!" do not light it in the camping or lot areas! THERE WILL BE NO FINE - YOU WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE AND YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO RETURN, PERIOD. If you return, you will be slapped with a nightcrawler.*

GAS/FUEL: No gasoline storage allowed. Propane tanks larger than 30lbs are prohibited. *Boom!*
